Appendix-B

Urban Core is a non-profit, community health centre that supports individuals and families who are homeless or at risk of homelessness, many of whom face overlapping barriers related to race, income, and access to care. Their work is grounded in harm reduction, equity, and culturally responsive support—particularly for Black communities in Hamilton.

This Black History Month, they are hosting a community event focused on celebration, connection, and culturally grounded health promotion for community members who are often excluded from traditional spaces. They have reached out to ask if CUPE 3906 would consider supporting this event through a donation.

Our support would directly help Urban Core create a welcoming, affirming space for Black community members experiencing housing insecurity—turning Black History Month into a moment of real, tangible care.
