Proposal for End-of-Term Postdoc Lunch Gathering

Target Audience:

Expected Attendance:

Approximately 40 postdocs, ensuring an engaging and interactive environment for networking and socializing.

Menu & Catering Details:

- Cost per person: 30 CAD (for a set menu or a selection of platters).
- Total food cost for 40 people: $30 \text{ CAD } \times 40 = 1,200 \text{ CAD}$
